Mosques in Austria

In Austria Islam is the religion of the largest minority and the second most widespread in the country. According to the Austrian Academy of Sciences in 2016, it is practiced by about 8% of the total population and most Muslims in Austria adopt the Sunni sect.

Austria has a total of 205 registered mosques, along with hundreds of unregistered ones. To make it easy for you to visit a mosque or to find a suitable place for prayer while on vacation in Austria, we have compiled a list featuring the most well-known mosques and prayer facilities popular with the local Muslim population all over the country.

Anti-Face-Covering Act

As part of the interdependence and social integration package, the Austrian government passed a law banning the covering of the face, which came into effect on 1st October 2017. As per the law, anyone who covers his/her face in public places, using the burqa or niqab for example, is subject to an administrative penalty of up to 150 euros, which can be imposed by police personnel. Covering your hair however, using a veil or ghutra for example, is still permitted.
